History and Impact of Internet Addiction


Historical Context and Societal Impact

• History:

• Societal Impact:

- Decline in physical health due to sedentary lifestyle
- Diminished academic and work performance

• Youth:

- Impaired social skills
- Academic challenges

• Families:

- Strained relationships (Yarahmadi et al., 2020)
- Increased family conflicts

• Community:

- Reduced community engagement
- Higher healthcare costs

• Internet Addiction Prevention Program for Youths

• Components:

- Digital literacy education
- Promoting balanced digital use
- Encouraging physical and community activities (Tso et al., 2022)

• Implementation:

- Workshops in schools and community centers
- Parental involvement and education
- Collaboration with mental health professionals
